Comments/Suggestions/Feedback

We have been asked if we can lock the toilet doors so that children can't go on their own but this isn't possible. Children are taught independence and encouraged to use the facilities as soon as they need to, we will continue to re-assure the children to ask a member of staff for help.

We have been asked if we can provide longer days. Currently, we have no plans to increase our sessions.

We have been asked if we can provide home learning activities to support the weekly activities in Preschool. We have a weekly theme and plan activities based on that theme, as well as activities to cover areas required for different groups of children under the Early Years Foundation Stage.

However we very much believe in learning through play and we adapt and change what is on offer depending on what the children want to do. We do not have a curriculum to follow and therefore weekly home learning activities would not be possible for us to prepare.
